

NC EPSDT: Screening Intervals with Coding at Well Visits

With updates in screening codes over the last year, many have been confused about the correct use of the codes. In the grid below are the CPT codes to be billed for the age-specific screens associated with the visit. Note that **two 96110 codes** are appropriate and payable in the same visit. If you are a clinician, please share this with your billing staff. If you are a biller, please share this with your practice clinicians.
