What will future PMH reimbursement look like?

The Prepaid Health Plan contracts are being finalized, but the program content remains the same and providers can refer to the Management of High-Risk Pregnancies and At-Risk Children in Managed Care program guide. On page 3, its states the provider incentives will remain the same during the three-year transition period.
