

Community Care Recruitment Scholarship Program

Initiative of CCNC's Center for Community-Based Primary Care and CCPN commenced in 2025. Applications for 2026 begin December 2025.

Community Care Physician Network (CCPN) and Community Care of North Carolina (CCNC) recognize primary care's critical role in ensuring healthy communities. We want to support a robust primary care delivery system across our state, especially in our most rural and vulnerable communities.

CCNC's Center for Community Based Primary Care created the **Community Care Recruitment Scholarship Program** to positively impact a primary care workforce pipeline.

The Community Care Recruitment Program

This program is aimed at residents, new physicians, Family Nurse Practitioners (NPs) and Physician Assistants (PAs) specializing in family medicine, pediatrics or general internal medicine willing to commit to practice in an independent CCPN practice and also open to serving as community-based primary care clinicians, as we understand their value to the primary care delivery system.

The **Community Care Recruitment Program** will provide unrestricted funds to incentivize eligible primary care clinicians to practice in a CCPN practice serving vulnerable populations, including Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries.

The Community Care Recruitment Program will:

- Provide a **Physician Scholarship of up to \$150,000** with an additional \$20,000 for practicing in a region with an HPSA score higher than 14. The funds will be distributed at \$30,000 a year for five years.
- Target residents in the **second and third year** of Family Medicine, Pediatric or General Internal Medicine Residency Programs.
- Require a **commitment to practice in a CCPN practice** and participate in the Center's Venture Mentorship Program.
- Link all recipients to a **dedicated team of experienced physicians and community business leaders to mentor them** in their journey into community based primary care.
- **Provide a NP/PA Scholarship of \$60,000**, with an additional \$5,000 for practicing in a region with an HPSA score higher than 14. Funds of \$12,000 a year for five years will be distributed upon graduation and employment in a CCPN practice.
